

Bishop's Waltham Parish Council is responsible for improving the local community and represents the whole electorate within the parish. It delivers services to meet local needs and strives to improve the quality of life for its residents.

The Parish Council has the powers to spend money on community transport, traffic calming, crime prevention, youth projects, tourism activities, leisure facilities, community centres, car parks, recreation grounds, entertainment, street furniture, street cleaning, allotments, bus shelters and land. It comments on planning applications and can be represented at public inquiries. It is likely to be granted more powers to negotiate with the local principal authorities and take on additional responsibilities.

Sustainable Community Strategy

Winchester City Council has four Strategic objectives:

- ACTIVE COMMUNITIES
- HIGH QUALITY ENVIRONMENT
- PROSPEROUS ECONOMY
- EFFECTIVENESS AND EFFICIENCY

The Parish Council resolved to structure its own Forward Plan according to these Objectives. The content, however, was to come entirely from the local community.

The Forward Plan

The Actions

The Parish Council has spent much time and effort over the past years engaging with local residents to find out what the community wants. The Forward Plan contains a list of Actions derived from many sources including surveys of the community, feedback from residents and comments on the Development Plan.

The Parish Council and its Committees

There are 14 Parish Councillors who are elected every four years. They are unpaid and are governed by a mandatory code of conduct which includes obligations to act in an appropriate way.

Councillors have three main components to their work:

- Decision making on money spent, services delivered and policies implemented
- *Monitoring* the efficiency and effectiveness of services
- *Getting involved locally* in meeting the wider community and involving local organisations

There are a number of committees, those responsible for the Forward Plan being:

- Finance, Policy and Resources: Oversees the financial, manpower and land resources of the Council.
- **Planning, Environment and Highways**: Advises the Council on all action required to be taken with local planning, highway and associated authorities on matters relating to local and district highways, road safety and similar matters affecting the parish.
- Halls and Grounds: Manages the recreation grounds, public open space, allotments, amenity land and buildings owned by the Council.
- **Community Development**: Promotes Bishop's Waltham, its businesses and facilities.
