The Parish PROW Officer had attended workshops set up by the Hampshire Countryside Access Engagement Officer which had been useful, although aimed more at those new to the role. The Bishop's Waltham Explorer leaflet had been highlighted as a example of good practice as well as photos of the improvements made to a footpath in the town showing collaboration between HCC and local groups.

Annual Meeting of the Parish 2019 – review notes from the working group – for consideration The report was reviewed and it was noted that very few attendees wanted a public question and answer session within the meeting and it was highlighted that any queries could be answered in a personal and individual basis in the designated session in the second part of the event. It was suggested that the theme of the next meeting should be a review of work achieved so far on the Forward Plan.

The demography of the audience was noted and a small sample of feedback from the age group 30-50 sought. The reply given was that they were satisfied with the work the Parish Council provided and had no issues to raise at the meeting. They had time restrictions for evening opportunities but could offer no alternative time as more convenient. The committee noted that publicity for the meeting was given well in advance and all members of the community were encouraged to attend.

A few comments were made to consider for next year's event, in addition or confirmation of those already collated, to provide designated easily accessible seating for the disabled, ensure flow of the

'Clean Up Bishop's Waltham' - Litter Picking event - review notes from the working group - for consideration

The event was noted as very successful in terms of organisation and response by volunteers. A tried and tested format was in place and should continue for future occasions. A grant from Winchester City Council had been applied for, and successfully awarded, to purchase equipment related to community clean up events, high street cleaning and enhancing pride in the high street. The new equipment would be used to support future events.

It was considered if the event should be held twice a year (Spring and Autumn) but at present the litter issue was under control and no demand from the public was leading to the need for another event in the Autumn. It was noted that other organisations, such as the Scouts and Guides, also did litter pick events to support the town.
