Serving Hampshire Consultation


Serving Hampshire Consultation

Jubilee Hall Car Park

For many years the lack of car parking spaces in the Town Centre has been reported as a major concern to the Bishop's Waltham community. The Parish Council has resolved to extend the car park at The Jubilee Hall from 49 to 120 metered spaces. The cost will result in your annual precept increasing by approximately 4% or £5.38 pa on a typical Band D property. It is important to the Parish Council that the community is in agreement with the increase in council tax in order to fund the work involved. Accessible Gate onto Hoe Road Recreation Ground

In response to comments made to the Parish Council from people using mobility scooters, and those with pushchairs, who couldn't easily access Hoe Road Recreation Ground, a new wider gate has been installed at the footpath between the Recreation Ground and Hamble Springs. We hope that residents find this new gate increases accessibility.
