Welcome

During the last three months of every year your Parish Councill Committees agree their financial budget requests for the following year, and 2021 was no exception, despite the working restrictions posed by Covid regulations.

Once again, as highlighted below, we have been able to keep the increase below the rate of inflation, despite the loss of approximately \pounds 50,000 of income from the hire of our Halls & Grounds facilities.





Dog Waste Bin Locations



There are 19 dog waste bins located in Bishop's Waltham managed by the Parish Council, three of which are supplied with free to use dog waste bags. These bins and bags are provided at a cost to the Parish Council of £5,500 a year.

Most dog owners are responsible and pick up their dogs' mess. If you don't, you're not only creating a nasty, smelly mess for other people, you're committing a crime. If you are caught, you could be fined up to £80. Please put dog mess in a plastic bag and leave it in any litter bin or any of our special dog waste bins.

Please be considerate to other users when taking dog waste bags provided.



Bishop's Waltham Parish Council Grants

Bishop's Waltham Parish Council supports a wide range of grants and particularly welcomes applications from small or newly formed groups and those that have not applied to the Council previously. The amount of money available for grants varies each year, depending on the overall Council budget. An application form can be downloaded from the Parish Council's website or collected from the office. Applicants are required to submit all information detailed on the form and any requested by the Parish Council.

Tree Planting

The Parish Council Groundsmen and Lengthsman have been busy planting trees around the Parish. These trees are part of the Queen's Green Canopy, an initiative marking the Queen's Platinum Jubilee (https://queensgreencanopy.org/). 165 trees have been planted with more still to come. Varieties planted include Crab Apple,



Dogwood, Dog Rose, Hawthorne, Hazel, Rowan, Silver Birch and Wild Cherry. New copses have been planted in Priory Meadow and Priory Park. Small tree groups have been planted at Churchill Avenue Play Park and a row of Cherry Trees sited on Victoria Road green. Some of these young trees, called whips, will replace dead trees, while others have been used to fills gaps in hedges. Please look out for the new additions when you are out and about.

Ditch/Drain Clearing

The Parish Council have been clearing ditches on Parish Council land and working closely with Hampshire County Council to ensure drains around the town are clear.

Bishop's Waltham residents/Groups (consisting of 50% residents) benefit from a 10% price reduction on hire rates.
