Public Session

The resident who was a member of the Enhanced Bus Partnership spoke about the proposed timetable for the new 49 bus service that was to replace the X9 and X10 services. The timetable that was due to commence operation on Monday 3rd March, did not allow for onward connections with other bus and rail services. The resident has suggested an amended timetable, to improve connectivity but this had not been adopted. The resident requested that the Parish Council, who had been represented in the discussions with HCC, respond to the HCC with their views on the timetable. They suggested the Parish Council consider whether the new service offered the best value for the public money being spent on the service and whether it met the goals specified in the Bus Improvement Plan.

The Headteacher of the Infant School had contacted the Council to discuss whether a commemorative item would be gifted to local school children. This was to be discussed further during the agenda item to discuss the Coronation event.
